With the exception of the changes below, all terms and conditions of the Colorado Plateau CESU Agreement apply to this Amendment, and this Amendment is hereby made part of the Agreement.

ARTICLE I. BACKGROUND AND OBJECTIVES

A.3. The Hopi Tribe, a sovereign nation, is hereby added in partnership with the Navajo Nation, U.S. Government Federal Agencies, Northern Arizona University (Host University), and nonfederal Partner Institutions in the Colorado Plateau CESU.

ARTICLE III. TERM OF AGREEMENT

- A.1. The effective date of the Colorado Plateau CESU Cooperative and Joint Venture Agreement is 18 June 2019.
- A.2. The effective date of this Amendment to the Colorado Plateau CESU Cooperative and Joint Venture Agreement shall be determined from the date of the last signature to this Amendment.

ARTICLE X. REQUIRED/SPECIAL PROVISIONS

Under Section A. REQUIRED PROVISIONS, Subsection 6. LIABILITY PROVISION, the following is hereby added, with subsequent subsections re-numbered accordingly.

- b) The Hopi Tribe

- (1) Nothing in this agreement shall constitute a waiver of sovereign immunity of The Hopi Tribe.

- (2) The Hopi Tribe's obligations under this agreement are subject to available appropriations.
