With the exception of the changes below, all terms and conditions of the Californian CESU Cooperative and Joint Venture Agreement apply to this Amendment, and this amendment is hereby made part of the agreement.

#### ARTICLE I BACKGROUND AND OBJECTIVES

A.1. The Department of Defense–Office of Deputy Under Secretary of Defense (Installations and Environment) is included in the Californian CESU as a Federal Agency partner under Agreement # W912DY-06-2-0023.

The Department of Defense (hereinafter called DoD) manages nearly 29 million acres of land, and the natural and cultural resources found there, and for this agreement includes the Office of the Secretary of Defense, the Military Services, the Defense Logistics Agency, the National Guard Bureaus, and the Military Reserve Components. DoD's primary mission is national defense. DoD's conservation program supports this mission by ensuring realistic training areas, and managing its resources in ways that maximize available land, air, and water training opportunities. DoD environmental stewardship activities are authorized under the Sikes Act, as amended. In accordance with one or more of the following: 16 U.S.C. 670c-1, 10 U.S.C. 2358, 10 U.S.C. 2384, 10 U.S.C. 2394, and P.L. 103-139 (FY 94 NDAA page 107 Stat. 1422), the DoD is authorized to enter into this cooperative agreement to establish the Californian CESU to assist in providing research, technical assistance, and education.

- A.2 The Cal Poly Corporation, California Polytechnic State University is included in the Californian CESU as a Partner Institution.
- A.3. CSU, Chico Research Foundation, California State University, Chico is included in the Californian CESU as a Partner Institution.
- A.4 Humboldt State University is included in the Californian CESU as a Partner Institution.

#### ARTICLE III TERM OF THE AGREEMENT

- A.1. The effective date of the Californian CESU Cooperative and Joint Venture Agreement is 2 July 2003.
- A.3. The effective date of this amendment to the Californian CESU Cooperative and Joint Venture Agreement shall be determined from the date of the last signature to this amendment.
