With the exception of the changes below, all terms and conditions of the Chesapeake Watershed CESU Cooperative Agreement apply to this Amendment, and this Amendment is hereby made part of the agreement.

ARTICLE I. BACKGROUND AND OBJECTIVES

F.1. Information on the Department of Defense is amended as follows:

The Department of Defense (hereinafter called DoD) manages nearly 29 million acres of land, and the natural and cultural resources found there, and for this agreement includes the Office of the Secretary of Defense, the Military Services, the Defense Logistics Agency, the National Guard Bureaus, and the Military Reserve Components. DoD's primary mission is national defense. DoD's conservation program supports this mission by ensuring realistic training areas, and managing its resources in ways that maximize available land, air, and water training opportunities. DoD environmental stewardship activities are authorized under the Sikes Act, as amended. In accordance with one or more of the following: 16 U.S.C. 670c-1, 10 U.S.C. 2358, 10 U.S.C. 2384, 10 U.S.C. 2394, and P.L. 103-139 (FY 94 NDAA page 107 Stat. 1422), the DoD is authorized to enter into this cooperative agreement to continue the Chesapeake Watershed CESU to assist in providing research, technical assistance, and education.

H.2. Delaware State University is included in the Chesapeake Watershed CESU as Partner Institutions.

ARTICLE III. TERM OF THE AGREEMENT

- A.1. The effective date of the Chesapeake Watershed CESU Cooperative and Joint Venture Agreement is 4 August 2006.
- A.6. The effective date of this amendment to the Chesapeake Watershed CESU Cooperative and Joint Venture Agreement shall be determined from the date of the last signature.
