ARTICLE I. BACKGROUND AND OBJECTIVES

- A.2. The National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) is hereby included in the Chesapeake Watershed CESU as a Federal Agency Partner.
- M.5. The American Indian Higher Education Consortium, Association of African American Museums, Gallaudet University, Indiana University, Johns Hopkins University, Live It, Learn It, Monmouth University, NatureServe, and Temple University are hereby included in the Chesapeake Watershed CESU as Partner Institutions.
- P. <u>National Aeronautics and Space Administration</u>. The National Aeronautics and Space Administration (hereinafter called NASA) has among its missions the utilization of aeronautical and space activities for scientific purposes, encompassing research designed to expand knowledge of the Earth, its resources, and the effects of climatic change on the transformation of its ecological systems. In addition, NASA is responsible for the environmental stewardship of the land, water, and wildlife resources under its control. In accordance with 51 U.S.C. § 20113 (e) of the National Aeronautics and Space Act of 1958 (51 U.S.C. § 20101 et seq.), NASA is authorized to enter into this cooperative agreement to continue the Chesapeake Watershed CESU to assist in providing research, technical assistance, and education.

ARTICLE III. TERM OF AGREEMENT

- A.1. The effective date of the Chesapeake Watershed CESU Cooperative and Joint Venture Agreement is 05 August 2016.
- A.2. The effective date of this Amendment to the Chesapeake Watershed CESU Cooperative and Joint Venture Agreement shall be determined from the date of the last signature.
