ARTICLE I. BACKGROUND AND OBJECTIVES

- A.2. The US Fish and Wildlife Service is included in the Upper and Middle Mississippi Valley CESU as a Federal Agency partner under Cooperative Agreement # 301816J229.
- I. The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (hereinafter call USFWS) working with others, is responsible for conserving, protecting, and enhancing fish, wildlife, plants and their habitats for the continuing benefit of the American people through Federal programs related to migratory birds, endangered species, interjurisdictional fish and marine mammals, and inland sport fisheries. In accordance with 16 U.S.C. 742f, the USFWS is authorized to enter into this cooperative agreement to continue the Pacific Northwest CESU to assist in providing research, technical assistance and education.

ARTICLE III. TERM OF AGREEMENT

- A.1. The effective date of the Upper and Middle Mississippi Valley CESU Cooperative Agreement is 17 July 2003.
- A.3. The effective date of this amendment to the Upper and Middle Mississippi Valley CESU Cooperative Agreement shall be determined from the date of the last signature.
