ARTICLE I. BACKGROUND AND OBJECTIVES

A.4. The Narragansett Indian Tribal Historic Preservation Office (NITHPO) on behalf of the Narragansett Indian Tribe, a sovereign nation, joins in partnership with the U.S. Government Federal Agencies, the University of Rhode Island (Host Institution), and nonfederal Partner Institutions in the North Atlantic Coast CESU.

ARTICLE III. TERM OF AGREEMENT

A.1. The effective date of the North Atlantic Coast CESU Cooperative Agreement is 19 June 2009.

A.2. The effective date of this amendment to the North Atlantic Coast CESU Cooperative Agreement shall be determined from the date of the last signature.

ARTICLE X. REQUIRED/SPECIAL PROVISIONS

A.6. LIABILITY PROVISION:

The following language is inserted before Government Parties:

Narragansett Indian Tribe and the Narragansett Indian Tribal Historic Preservation Office (NITHPO):

(a) Nothing in this agreement shall constitute a waiver of sovereign immunity of the Narragansett Indian Tribe.

(b) The Narragansett Indian Tribe's obligations under this agreement are subject to available appropriations.
